## Lecture Series

**January 11, 2024 - February 2, 2024**

**Topic**                      **Periodic Lecture Series on Various Aspects of Ethics**

**Organized by**        **Department of Philosophy, JTGDC**

A periodic lecture series of 04 lectures on Various Aspects of Ethics funded by the **Indian Council of Philosophical Research, New Delhi**, was organised under the coordinator ship of Dr. Anurag Pandey, Dept. of Philosophy. Faculty members and Research Scholars of various colleges and the University of Allahabad actively participated in the lecture programme.

**Lecture 01-** held on Jan. 11, 2024, was delivered by Dr. Shiv Bhanu Singh, Rtd. Head, Department of Philosophy, ECC, Prayagraj. The topic of his deliverance was '**Gender Equality & Women Empowerment**'. Dr. Shiv Bhanu Singh has started his deliverance with the introduction of the topic and said that the term gender equality ensures equal access to economic, social, and political opportunities for all genders, in addition to fostering a culture wherein all genders are respected and safe. It is a state in which access to rights or opportunities are unaffected by genders. There has been a prejudice in the society regarding the womanhood even among the great thinkers and philosophers like Plato, Aristotle, St. Thomas Aquinas, George Bernard Shaw etc. Religious scriptures had also played a vital role in creating the prejudice against women. Dr. Singh said that Gender equality is not only a fundamental human right, but a necessary foundation for a peaceful, prosperous, and sustainable world. Comprehensive policy reforms are needed to dismantle systemic barriers. Gender equality is a cross-cutting objective and must be a key focus of national policies, budgets, and institutions.



**Lecture 02-** held on Jan. 17, 2024, was delivered by Prof. Rishi Kant Pandey, Head, Department of Philosophy, University of Allahabad. The topic of his lecture was '**Ethical and Religious Perspectives of Ecology**'. Prof. Rishi Kant Pandey has briefly differentiated the concept of Ecology and Environment. According to him environment is a broad scenario which refers to all the conditions that influence and affect the development and sustainability of life of all organisms present on the earth on the other hand Ecology is the study of inter-relationship of organisms with physical as well as biotic environments. He states that the previous ideologies have the concept of man as center of the nature. Man was the end and means in the nature. He used to consider as the creator and founder of the values and having intrinsic values. All other things have only instrumental value. They are only for the service of humans. This theory was known as anthropocentrism or homocentrism or human supremacism. After the World War II, due to industrial revolution consumerism-based society had been established. It was believed that consumer spending stimulates production and economic growth. But in real sense consumerism has been reflected as a tendency of people living in a capitalist economy to engage in a lifestyle of excessive materialism that revolves around reflexive, wasteful, or conspicuous overconsumption. In this sense, consumerism is widely understood to contribute to the destruction of traditional values and ways of life, consumer exploitation by big business, environmental degradation, and negative psychological effects. In contrast to this the concept of Deep Ecology was introduced by Arne Naess. Deep ecologism believes that humans should radically change their relationship with nature. Survival of the fittest should be understood through the human ability to cooperate and coexist with nature, as opposed to exploiting or dominating it. Deep ecologism thus prioritizes a 'live and let live' attitude over an 'either you or me' approach.

**Lecture 03-** held on Jan. 19, 2024, was delivered by Prof. Jata Shankar, Former Head, the Department of Philosophy, University of Allahabad. The topic of his deliverance was- '**Indian Value Systems**'. He stated Indian value system is surrounded by its prime feature Purushartha, the four goals of human life. Purushartha means the purpose of the Self. The four Puruṣārtha's are Dharma (righteousness, moral values), Artha (prosperity, economic values), Kama (psychological values) and Moksha (liberation, spiritual values, self-actualization). The ultimate goal of human life is self-realization and liberation from the cycle of reincarnation. Moksha is believed to occur when an individual has successfully achieved Artha, Kama and Dharma. Dharma and Moksha are the peripheries or the circumferences of life cycle between which Artha and Kama should be evaluated and practiced.

**Lecture 04-** held on Feb. 02, 2024, was delivered by Prof. S. P. Pandey, Former Head of the Department of Philosophy & Religion, Banaras Hindu University, Varanasi. The topic of his deliverance was – '**Vartmaan Chunaatiyaan evam Sanskritik Moolyabodh**'. Prof. S. P. Pandey, in the starting of the lecture, has briefly stated that the term Value is related to its root word that could be called fundamental. It's not in the sense of worth or any kind of economic value. Every society has its own cultures which are often different from each other. The reason for this difference is that any culture has its own ideals and values. These rules and norms are determined by the society based on its cultural values. In this way, Cultural value establishes a process and behavior according to the different cultures of the society and explains what is right and wrong in the society. Indian Culture and its value stages have been changed in this era and value systems has been diluted to its end. There are changing definitions of Dharama, culture and conceptual values and it has been accepted by the

millennia as a method to live their life. This is a post truth era where all the objectives have been diluted. Geopolitical reality and multiculturalism have now been considered as reality of the human being. Ancient established values are getting decayed. What is old is dying and what is new is yearning to be born. The ambition to prove truth as false has now been developed in human being. Our present generation is torn between the present and the future. We need to adopt such values which have sociality, practicality and scientific. A sublime form of which is found in the Satyarth Prakash of Swami Dayanand Saraswati. The problem is that we want to see the past by the eyes and perspectives of the present and do not understand that even the past shows the present in the same way. We no longer want to experience the combination of Paravidya in knowledge, Dharma in Karma and Rasa in experience.

## *Faculty enrichment Programme*

**March 15, 2024**

**Topic**                      **Workshop on Quality Assessment and Accreditation**

**Resource Person**      **Prof. Manoj Kumar, Dept of English, University of Allahabad**

**Organized by**            **Internal Quality Assurance Cell, Jagat Taran Girls' Degree College**

A one-day workshop on “*Quality Assessment and Accreditation*” was organized with full participation from the college faculty and staff. Dr. Kajal Deb, a senior IQAC member, introduced the session and the Resource Person, **Prof. Manoj Kumar**.

Prof. Kumar emphasized that institutions do not need to create new activities for NAAC accreditation but must ensure **effective documentation** of existing events and achievements. He elaborated on the **NAAC assessment process**, focusing on the **Self-Study Report (SSR)**, **Student Satisfaction Survey**, and **Peer Team Report**. Key steps such as **IIQA submission**, **SSR uploading**, **DVV process**, and **peer team visit** were clearly outlined, including post-accreditation procedures and re-appeal options.

In the next session, Prof. Kumar provided a **detailed criterion-wise explanation of the SSR**:

- **Curriculum Aspects:** Academic planning, inclusion of value-based courses, feedback mechanisms, and student internships. Academic flexibility Record of certificate/value-added courses and MOOCs (SWAYAM/NPTEL). A student info center for MOOCs with nodal officers was suggested.
- **Teaching-Learning & Evaluation:** Enrolment ratio, student-teacher ratio, use of ICT, evaluation methods, and learning outcomes. Transparent processes and an efficient grievance redressal mechanism are necessary. Student Satisfaction Survey: At least 50% of students must participate.

- **Research, Innovation & Extension:** Research funding, publications, innovation practices, IPR awareness, and community engagement activities. Minimum 10 publications and 10 book chapters per faculty in five years. Community-oriented programs like NSS/NCC with geotagged evidence. Minimum 40 extension programs. Collaborations: At least 20 collaborative initiatives in five years are necessary
- **Infrastructure and Learning Resources:** Availability and maintenance of academic facilities, sports, ICT resources, Library, and audited expenditure.
- **Student Support & Progression:** Scholarships, skill enhancement, career counselling, placement records, student achievements, and grievance redressal mechanisms must be installed.
- **Governance, Leadership & Management:** Vision and mission alignment, implementation of e-governance, financial support to staff, audits, and quality initiatives. Records of participation in UGC-mandated programs like orientation and refresher courses.
- **Institutional Values & Best Practices:** Gender equity, sustainability practices, accessibility, environmental audits, and campus greening efforts. Best Practices: Examples such as *Swaabhimaan Thali*, *sanitary pad ATMs*, *remedial classes*, and community outreach should be documented with photos and reports.

The workshop provided a **comprehensive roadmap for NAAC accreditation**, with detailed guidance on documentation, planning, and institutional development across all seven criteria. Prof. Kumar's insights aimed to empower the faculty and staff to align with NAAC standards through existing activities, effective reporting, and strategic improvements. The session was highly informative and served as a valuable capacity-building exercise for all participants.
