About the college

Jagat Taran Girls' Degree College was established in year 1975 as an associated college of the University of Allahabad. It became a constituent college of Allahabad Central University w.e.f July 14, 2005. The college is run by Jagat Taran Education Society which comprises of educationists, social thinkers and philanthropists.

The college has been accredited with 'A' grade at CGPA of 3.19 by NAAC (II cycle) on November 30, 2011. It has been selected by the UGC as College with Potential for Excellence in 2010 and again for CPE (phase-II) w.e.f. F.Y. 2014-15.

Located in the heart of the city near Anand Bhawan and Allahabad University, the college is easily accessible by local means of transport. It provides a spacious campus and requisite infrastructure with all modern facilities.

The college offers U.G. courses in Arts and Commerce faculties. P.G. Course in selected subjects is also available. The Bachelor of Arts programme is aided by the government while Bachelor of Commerce is self financed. The College also offers Diploma in Computer Application and various certificate and skill development programmes. N.C.C., N.S.S. various Literary, Cultural and Sports activities are organised for overall development of personality of students. The faculty members of the college adopt innovative methods of teaching-learning for the benefit of students. The alumni of the college have established themselves in various professional, legal, administrative and academic fields.
