The proposed Plan of Action for the session 2015 – 16 was prepared by IQAC including the suggestions from experts, faculty members, students and stakeholders. The same was placed before the Cell in the meeting dated May 12, 2015 and approved. The following suggestions were made.

Prof. Bhutani suggested :

- Demarcation of land of Degree College should be identified.
- He suggested atleast three skill development courses for the students to complete in three years.
- He suggested for socio – economic survey: (data collection, number of schools, number of students, medical facilities, economic status, teacher taught ratio etc.) survey report should be documented.
- He also suggested to encourage Desktop Publishing (DTP) course and Hindi typing, Journalism in Computer.
- Dr. Ruchi Mittal suggested that graphic designing, printing language, speaking and writing should also be included in skill development course. Expression power and confidence to be developed. Personality development and communication skill should be the part of every student.
- It was suggested by Sumedha an Alumna to introduce B.Ed. classes.
- Prof. Pratima Gaur suggested to encourage physiotherapy training especially for old people of the society.
- Old ladies of the society may be identified to support them.

The coordinator informed that the suggestions made by the Advisory Committee will be included in the Plan of Action and will be finalized in the meeting of the Staff Council which will be implemented in the Session 2015 – 16.
