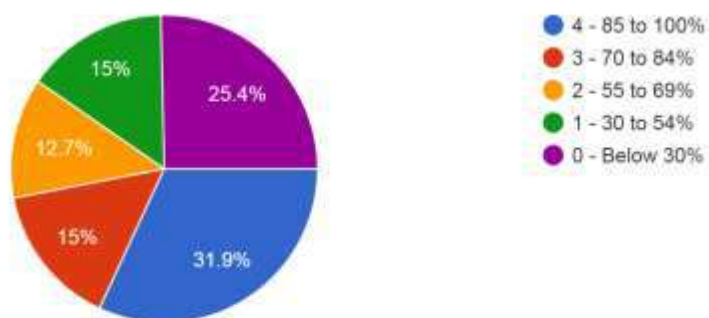

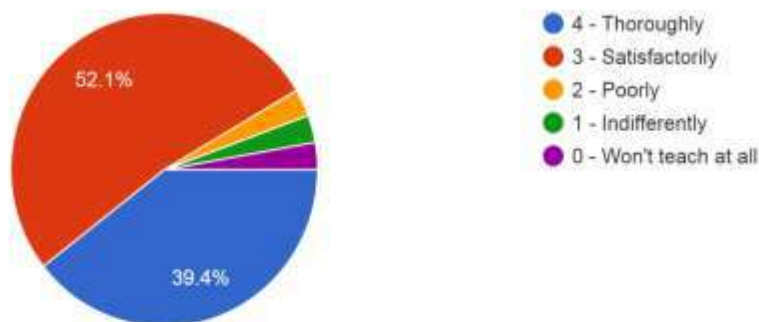
1. How much of the syllabus was covered in the class?

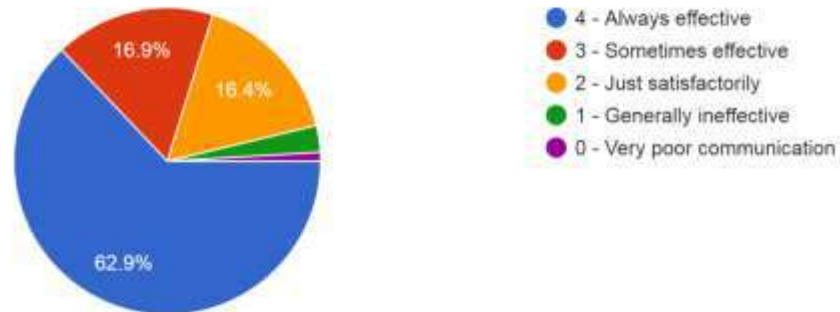
2. How well did the teachers prepare for the classes?

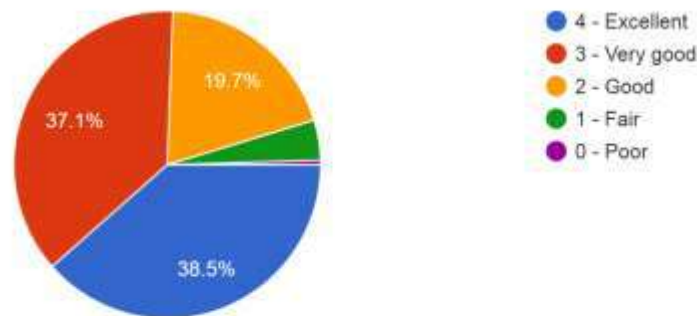
3. How well were the teachers able to communicate?

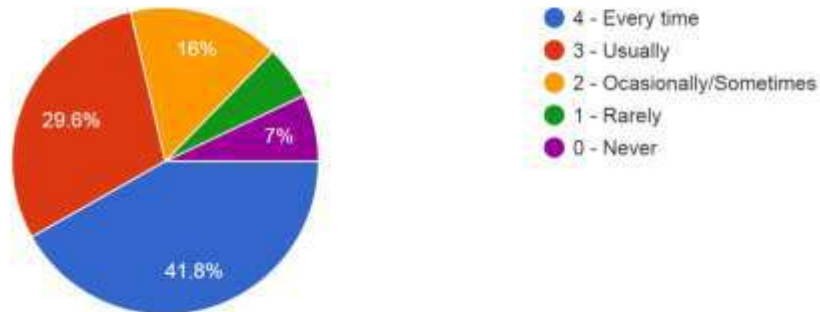
5. Fairness of the internal evaluation process by the teachers:

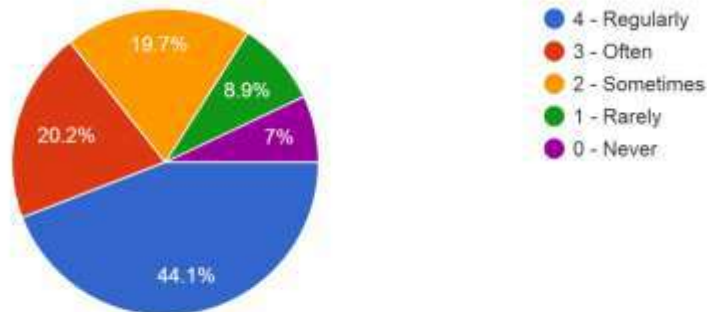
6. Was your performance in assignments discussed with you?

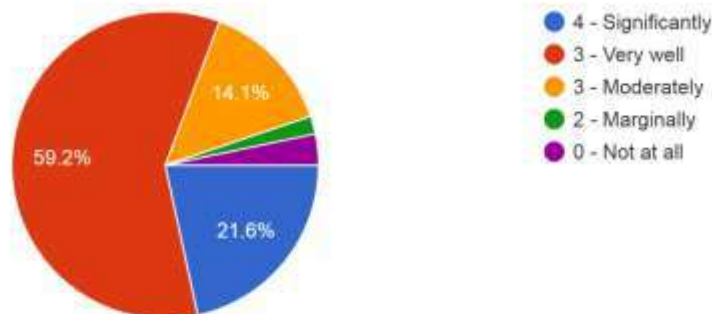

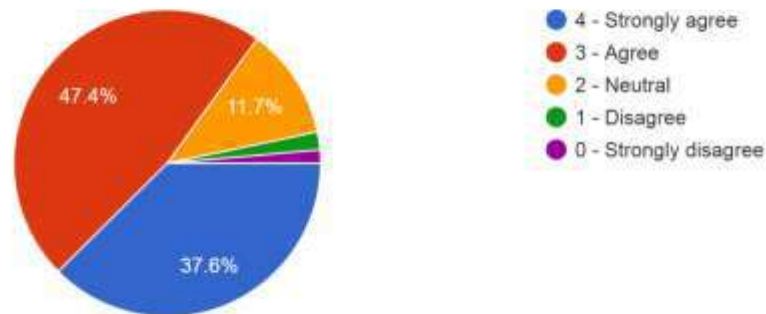
8. The teaching and mentoring process in your institution facilitates you in cognitive, social and emotional growth:

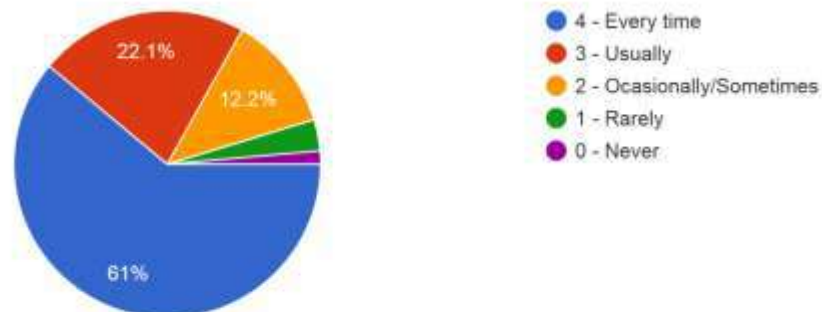

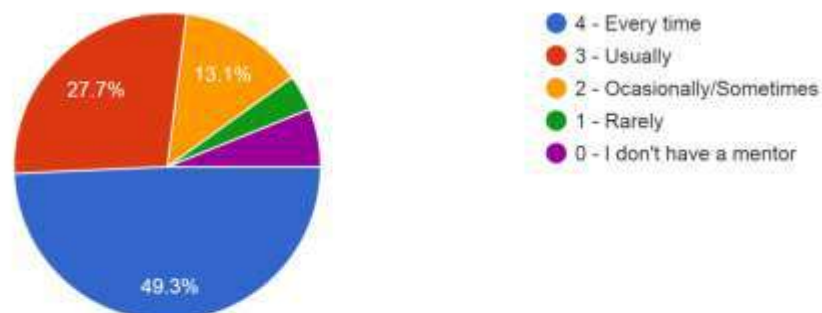
10. Teachers inform you about your expected competencies, course outcomes and program outcomes:

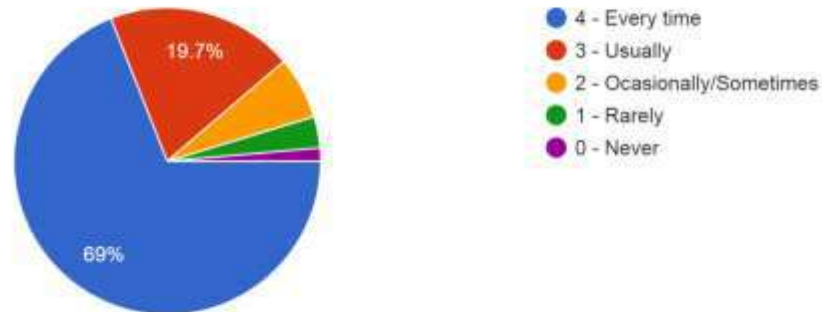

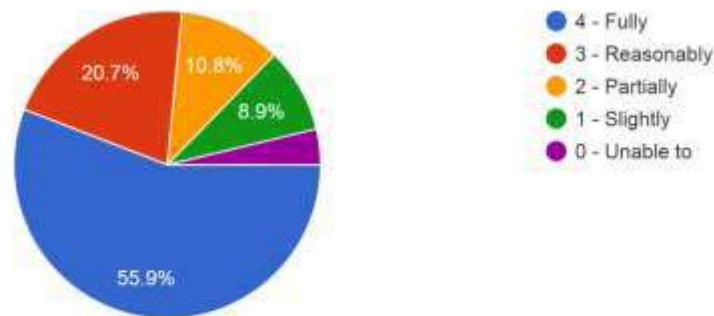
12. The teacher illustrates the concepts through examples and applications:

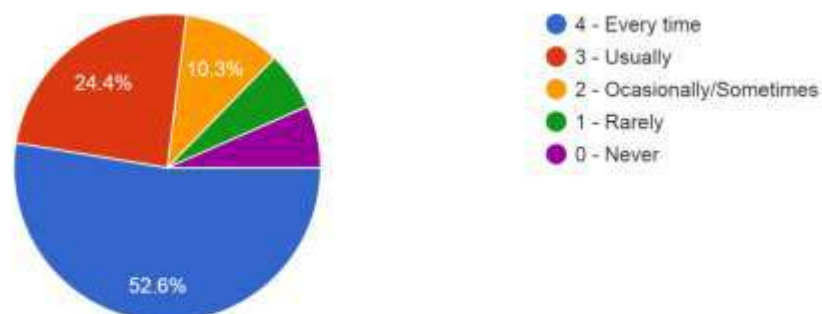

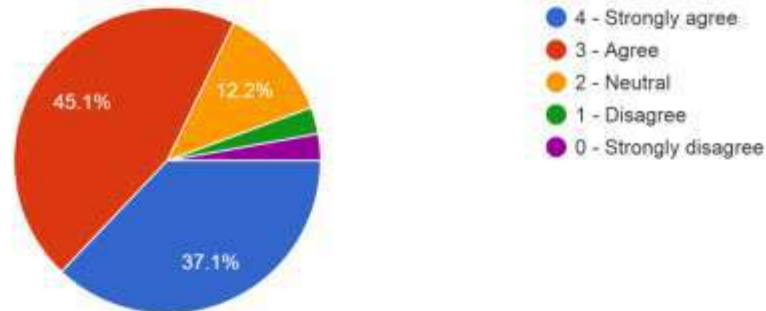

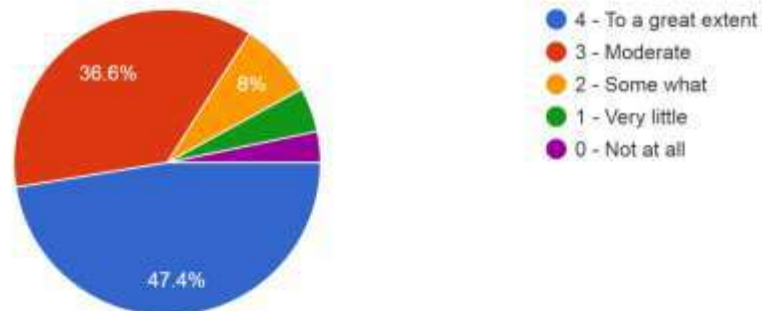
15. The institution makes effort to engage students in monitoring, review and continuous quality improvements of the teaching-learning process:

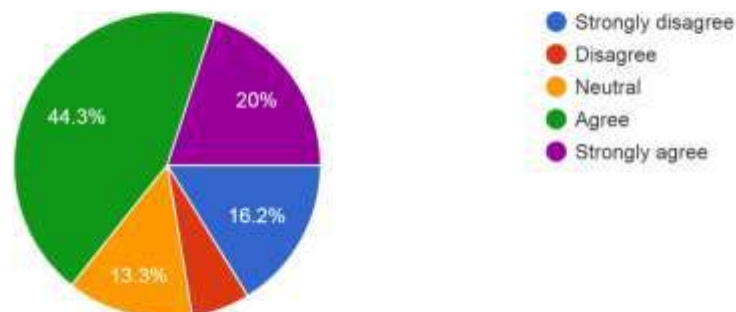

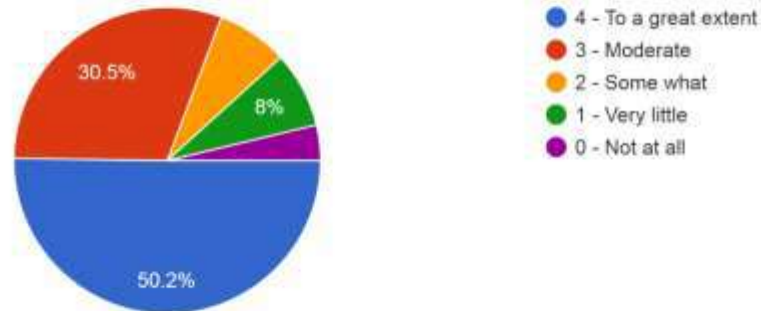
17. Teachers encourage you to participate in the extracurricular activities:

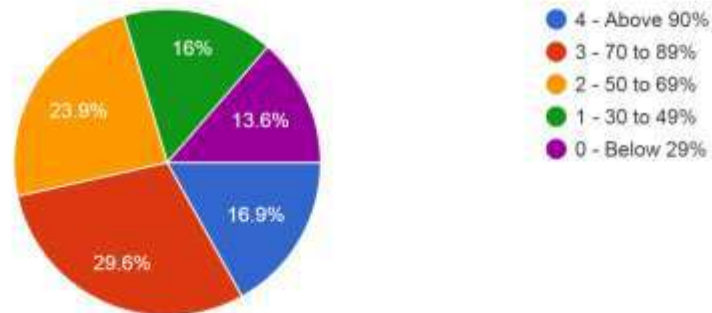

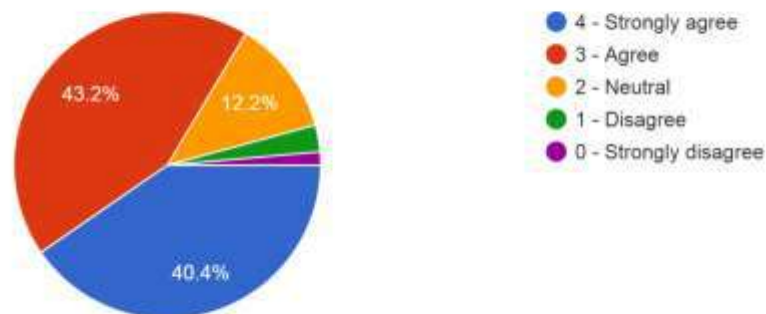
19. What percentage of teachers use ICT tools such as LCD projector, multimedia etc while teaching?
