**Topic**                **Relevance of Mahatma Gandhi in Post Modern Era**

Mr. Avatans Kumar, Trustee of Indic Academy & President of its US Branch INDICA, USA spoke at length on 'Gandhian Philosophy in 21<sup>st</sup> Century'. ## International Webinar

Feb 22-23, 2021

**Topic** Contemporary World Literature and Art Forms

**Organized by** Department of English

The Department of English, Jagat Taran Girls' PG College, University of Allahabad organized a two-day **International Webinar on Contemporary World Literature and Art Forms on February 22 and 23, 2021**.

Day 1 began with the formal welcome by the Principal Dr Kamla Dubey to the Chairman of the Governing Body, Jagat Taran PG College, Prof Ashim Mukherjee, and the esteemed speakers for the event. The Convenor of the Webinar Dr Fatima Noori read the concept note and introduced the speakers.

**Prof Kian Pishkar**, Vice President of S & T, Head of Postgraduate Department of English Language and Literature, Islamic Azad University, Iran delivered his lecture on "Melanie Klein's perspective and object relation theory in Ian McEwan's *Nutshell*" where he focused on how the Shakespearean retelling of the Hamlet story in the novel focuses on the mother-child relationship to unfold the mysteries of the plot.

**Prof Lakshmi Raj Sharma**, Ex-Head, Department of English & Modern European Languages, University of Allahabad delivered his lecture on "Writing English Novels in India Today". Professor Sharma talked about the difficulties and hurdles of writing and publishing in India in the contemporary times especially in context of the vibrant competition from the television and internet.

**Day 2** began with the principal's welcome to the guests and the summarization of Day 1 lectures by the Convenor Dr Fatima Noori.

The first Lecture for the day was on "Travelling Art Forms: The case of the Ghazal" by **Prof Asim Siddiqui**, Department of English, Aligarh Muslim University, who traced the origins of the poetic form from Arabic to Persian, Urdu and Hindi to English and Spanish. His focus was on how the ghazal as a poetic and as an art form has flourish and in turn enriched the literary scene in many languages.

The second lecture of Day 2 "Narrative Empathy and Conflict in Mirza Waheed's *The Book of Golden Leaves* was delivered by **Dr. Arnab Dutta Roy**, Visiting Professor Stockton University, New Jersey who focused on the power stories to build up the values of empathy and universal brotherhood.

**Dr Dr. Chuyun Oh**, Assistant Professor of Dance, San Diego State University, Fulbright scholar (2015) talked about the "Diasporic, Hybridized, Alternative Cultural Identities: A Critical Examination of K-Pop Dance" to elaborate the popular Korean Pop culture and art form as sites of identity creation and well as reorganization.

## Workshop

**July 7-13, 2020**

**Topic** E-Learning and E-Content Development for Teachers and Research Scholars

**Organized by** Department of Geography, Department of Education and Multimedia Lab

The present workshop aimed to develop modern technical expertise among teachers and researchers in this pandemic era and even after in future when online learning and teaching are becoming more relevant and popular. Total 116 participants from different disciplines and from 17 states of the country had joined the workshop. 50% of the participants were assistant professors, 25% were associate professors and professors, the remaining 25% were research scholars.

The workshop comprised of two sessions per day in which first session was used to be a Lecture cum demonstration session and the other was used to be a Self-practice session under the guidance of Mentors. In this way the workshop engaged its participants for a total of 35 hours consisted of 17.5 hours each for Contact sessions as well as Practice sessions respectively. The day-wise details are as follows:

**Day 1: July 7, 2020:** Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor of the University, Prof. R. R. Tiwari was the Chief Guest and addressed the participants. The Patron of this workshop, Prof. Ashim Kumar Mukherjee, Chairman, Governing body of this College & Dean, Faculty of Commerce, University of Allahabad focused upon the emergent need of the use of technology in today's teaching-learning environment. The Key-Note speaker Prof. Y. Narasimhulu, Director, UGC-HRDC, University of Hyderabad talked about the “Need for Online

Education and The Architectural Design of Online Resources” in detail to orient participants towards dynamics of online education in two consecutive sessions.

Malkar, Head, Department of Business Administration (MBA), Sanjivani College of Engineering, Kopergaon (Maharashtra) described the tools for editing video lectures and creation of online content with the help of mobile and laptop/desktop applications.

Gupteshwar Rao arranged virtual trips for the participants with the help of virtual reality tools with the help of various Augmented Reality (AR) tools and applications.

**Day 4: July 10, 2020:** Fourth day, Dr. Parveen K. Sharma, Assistant Professor, Maharishi Markandeshwar University, Mullana, Ambala (Haryana) demonstrated the art to make a podcast on anchor and focused on the use of learning management system, Edmodo and launching a course on ZillLearn.

**Day 5: July 11, 2020:** Fifth day, Prof. R. C. Sharma, School of Global Affairs of Dr. B. R. Ambedkar University, Delhi talked about Open Educational Resources (OER), Creative Commons (CC) and scripting for online Courses, Learning Management System, MOODLE, Reference Management Tools etc.

**Day 6: July 12, 2020:** On the sixth day, Dr. Ganesh Madhe, Assistant Professor, S. S. M. Mahavidyalaya, Pune University, Pune, Maharashtra introduced participants with the video editing software named Camtasia.
